We hope the children are excited and eager to continue their learning journey at nursery.

Specific Nursery Arrangements for Arrival and Dismissal

From Wednesday the 12th August, nursery access gates will open at 8.45am.

- Nursery registration will be staggered from 8.45am to 9.15am to enable distancing and avoid congestion.
- Only one adult will be permitted to enter the school/nursery grounds and nursery 'Bubble' due to current Covid -19 safety guidelines.
- Staff will be available to support you to register your child quickly.
- Staff will be available to direct the children to hand sanitise on entry.
- Nursery children can be collected between 2.45pm and 3.15pm.
- A one way system direction for arrival and dismissal will be in place.
- Once you have collected your child please exit as quickly as possible.

Please note adults are asked to maintain 2m social distancing from other adults and from children of other households. Where this is difficult, our advice would be to wear a face covering where possible. We are required to keep the number of visitors to the nursery to a minimum, in accordance with national guidance. Any contact with the nursery should be made by telephone or email to the office in the first instance. Please take particular care if entering the nursery car park by vehicle during the time of nursery and school access hours 8.45am to 3.15pm.

Further advice, in line with national and South Lanarkshire Council guidelines, will be issued via the nursery website and twitter as it becomes available.
