Next-Steps in our Journey towards our 'New Normal'

Homework

Homework will begin from Monday 7th September 2020. It is important to build our homework activities gradually to support pupil re-engagement in learning and to take account of learners' social and emotional needs on return to school. Homework will be provided on Google Classroom from September 30th September to minimise transfer of resources from school to home. Homework jotters will be provided. Homework jotters **should not** be returned to school at the present time. Pictures of completed homework can be taken and uploaded to Google Classroom for teacher view. Printed diaries will be in use to provide information detailing your child's homework. It is recommended that school's sustain their use of online platforms e.g. Google Classroom as a contingency for any further requirement for children to access home learning. Paper copies will be available if digital access is not available.

PE

PE will continue to take place outdoors. PE will include core PE and active health PE. Children will only be required to wear PE kit for core PE. On core PE day, it is advised that children wear white polo-shirts, self-coloured black or navy trainers and a waterproof jacket to school to reduce changing requirements. Children can change into shorts or jogging trousers, as appropriate to weather conditions.

School Shoes
