

Curriculum News, Term 1 – August to December 2017

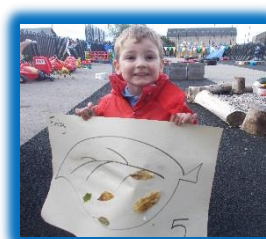
Nursery Life
