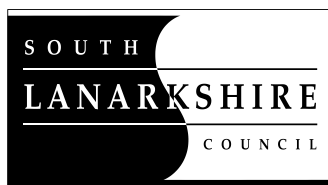

Adverse Weather Plan

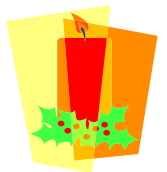
